HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the charge-sheet dated 30.04.2020 (Annexure P-1) issued by respondent No.1 wherein certain allegations of causing loss to state exchequer have been alleged against the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the allegations alleged in the charge-sheet are false, frivolous and vague hence, the charge-sheet dated 30.04.2020 (Annexure P-1) is liable to be set aside.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents, on the instructions from Mr. Jahid, Assistant, O/o FCR & ACS, Revenue Deapartment, Haryana (New Haryana Civil Secretariate) Sector-17, Chandigarh, submits that the proceedings qua the said charge sheet are already over and even the enquiry report has been submitted wherein, the allegations alleged against the petitioner have been proved and only the appropriate order is to be passed,

which could not be passed as the petitioner is delaying the same by not availing the chance given to him for personal hearing.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that appropriate order on the charge-sheet dated 30.04.2020 (Annexure P-1) will be passed within a period of four weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the enquiry report has already been submitted where the allegations have already been proved, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy in case any order causing prejudice to the petitioner is passed in the enquiry proceedings.

6. Ordered accordingly.
