Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short, '*the Cr.P.C.*'), praying for quashing of FIR No.234 dated 12.12.2005, registered at Police Station Traoari, District Karnal (subsequently treated as criminal complaint titled "Karamjit Kaur Vs. Nishan Singh and others" on the request of complainant Karamjit Kaur) as well as the order dated 19.05.2008, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Karnal, whereby, petitioner along with other co-accused, was summoned to face trial under Section 498-A and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, '*the IPC*').
