1. The present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to expeditiously dispose of the case titled as “Lt. Col. Ramandeep Singh Vs. Rashim Mahajan” bearing registration number Divorce and Matrimonial, Case No.703 of 2023 in a time bound manner, pending before the Ld. Family Court, Jalandhar.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would be satisfied if his application under Section 32 of the Army Act, 1950 which has not been entertained by the Family Court, Jalandhar, is entertained and disposed of in a time bound manner.
3. I have heard the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the file.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and in the interest of justice, the petitioner is directed to file an application under Section 32 of the Army Act, 1950 within a period of one week and in case, said application is moved, the concerned Court is directed to dispose of the same within a period of three weeks positively, after giving notice to the other party through counsel.
