MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners are seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondent No.6 and his companions as they are continuously harassing and threatening the petitioners with dire consequences.

2. Mr. Shubham Goyal, Advocate has entered appearance and filed his memorandum of appearance on behalf of respondent No.6 which is taken on record. He undertakes to file his power of attorney in the Registry of this Court.

3. Status report by way of affidavit of Manpreet Singh, PPS, Superintendent of Police (Rural), District SAS Nagar (Mohali), on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and 5, has been filed in the Court today which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

4. Learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to paragraph No.5 of the status report and submitted that since during investigation it was found to be a dispute essentially of civil nature between the parties, the matter had been consigned to the records.

5. In the wake of the status report filed by the State, a copy of which has also been given to the counsel opposite, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the instant petition and instead submits that he may be permitted to avail of alternate remedies under the provisions of law.

6. Dismissed as not pressed with liberty as prayed for.
