1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that the wife of petitioner No.2 died under suspicious circumstances and petitioner No.2 was convicted for her murder and his sentence has been suspended by Division Bench of this Court vide order dated 15.12.2022 and the copy of the said order is taken on record.

2. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that now petitioner No.2 has performed his second marriage with petitioner No.1 on 18.03.2024 and this is the first marriage of petitioner No.1 and both the petitioners are major but the aforesaid second marriage of petitioner No.2 is opposed by respondents No.4 and 5 who are extending threats to the petitioners and in this regard, petitioners have given representation dated 18.03.2024 Annexure P-4 to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and has not disputed the fact that first wife of petitioner No.2 is not alive and further submits that she was killed by petitioner No.2. The State counsel further submits that in case any such representation filed by the petitioner is pending then the same will be considered and disposed of in accordance with law by the competent authority, expeditiously.

5. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to consider representation dated 18.03.2024 (Annexure P-4) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

6. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
