1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of interim bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.33 dated 27.03.2023 under Sections 15(c)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.
2. In view of the report received from the DSP Sub Division, Abohar and the submissions made by the learned State counsel on the last date of hearing, whereby it had been brought to the notice of this Court that the condition of the petitioner’s wife is now stable and her parents-in-law are taking care of her, no ground is made out to extend the concession of interim bail to the petitioner. The petition, as such, stands dismissed.
