The proceedings in the present case were initiated in pursuance of an email sent to this Court by Dharmander Singh regarding the alleged illegal detention of his family members and their release.

In compliance of the order dated 22.03.2023 passed by this Court, present case was taken up by this Court on 01.04.2024, and the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar had produced Smt. Bateri, Ankur, Gaurav, Smt. Anita, Smt. Sarabjit and Inderjit before this Court. Since the said persons were not required by the police at this stage, they were permitted to move to a place of their choice.

I have perused the status report submitted by the Director General of Police, Punjab in the present case and this Court is satisfied that appropriate and necessary action has been taken against the erring police officials and it would be appropriate to give a quietus to the present case.

Even otherwise, as per the report of the Warrant Officer, no person was found detained illegally in Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar and accordingly the present petition is **disposed off**.

Needless to observe that Dharmander Singh, petitioner shall be at liberty to avail his alternative remedies, if any, available to him in accordance with law.
