1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 13.03.2024 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent No.4.

2. There is a dispute between petitioner, respondent No.5 and authorities with respect to deputation. The respondent No.5 has filed Civil Writ Petition No.19351 of 2011. The petitioner has filed instant petition. The respondent authorities are conducting inquiry. The petitioner was not associated in the inquiry which prompted him to file instant petition. The respondent No.5 has also filed petition with similar grievance.

3. Ms. Madhu Dayal, Advocate for respondents No.2 to 4



submits that in the *de novo* inquiry, in view of contents of CM No.15518 of 2024, the petitioner would be associated in the inquiry.

4. Mr. Alok Mittal, Advocate for respondent No.5 submits that he would withdraw his writ petition, if he is associated in the inquiry.

5. On being confronted with the statement of Mr. Alok Mittal, Ms. Madhu Dayal submits that respondent would permit respondent No.5 to join inquiry.

6. In the wake of statement of parties, the present petition stands disposed of with an observation that respondent No.1-U.T. Chandigarh would conduct fresh inquiry without being influenced by earlier reports. Let the needful be done within a period 3 months from today.

6. Pending misc. application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
