HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, submits that certain amount is yet to be paid by the petitioner towards the change of land use fee; and communication in this regard shall be served upon the legal heirs of the petitioner within a period of one week from today.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, thus, submits that in case, the said amount is not disputed by the legal heirs of the petitioner, it shall be deposited by them, within a period of two weeks thereafter.
3. In such circumstances, learned counsel for the respondent submits that in case, the legal heirs of the petitioner deposit the said amount, if any, appropriate orders on the site plan submitted by the petitioner (deceased) shall be passed within a period of two weeks thereafter and a copy thereof order shall be served upon the legal heirs of the petitioner

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within a week thereafter.

4. In view of the aforesaid stand taken by the parties, the present petition stands disposed of. It is made clear that the parties shall remain bound by their undertakings as mentioned herein above.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated stipulated period, as per undertaking given by learned counsel for the respondent, the petitioner (since deceased) thr. legal heirs would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the legal heirs of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

5. Rule stands discharged.
