The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant regular bail in case FIR No.121 dated 25.06.2023 registered under Sections 307, 506, 120-B, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar.
2. As per case of the prosecution, the complainant alleged that Sarthak, co-accused and his brother Partik, co-accused (both sons of the petitioner) were having dispute with Mandeep Singh alias Sahil.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely involved in the present case as he is father of Sarthak and Partik and had never participated in the alleged occurrence. Even otherwise, no specific role or injury has been attributed to the present petitioner. Learned counsel next contends that the petitioner was arrested in the present case on 19.01.2024 and the investigation is almost complete against him. Learned

counsel has placed reliance on the order dated 07.11.2023 (Annexure P-2), whereby co-accused Ranjit Singh alias Rana alias Vicky has been granted the concession of bail by this Court.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and submits that the petitioner is not entitled to be released on bail.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

6. In the present case, the petitioner was arrested on 19.01.2024 and is in custody for the last more than 02 months. The investigation is almost complete against him and the trial may take long time. Apart from that, co-accused Ranjit Singh alias Rana alias Vicky has already been granted the concession of bail by this Court vide order Annexure P-2.

7. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
