1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 13.03.2020 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No. 2 vide which it has been decided to transfer the affiliation of Adarsh Schools from CBSE Board to Punjab School Education Board.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 has submitted that in the present case, the parents of the children have filed the present writ

petition and since the students have passed out of the respective schools, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the above, the present petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted to the petitioners to revive the petition, in case, any cause of action survives.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with the aforesaid liberty.
