VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 08.03.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.1.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has submitted that petitioner who was a senior citizen has died and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the above, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted to the legal representatives of the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present case in case any cause survives to them.
4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
5. Liberty is however granted to the legal representatives of the petitioner to revive the present petition in case any cause survives to them.
