A request has been received from learned counsel for the petitioner to take up the matter through video conferencing mode.

The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.07, dated 21.01.2023, under Sections 15, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla.

This Court vide order dated 21.03.2024, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmeet does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.
