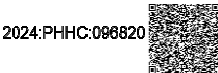

1. This application has been filed under Section 151 CPC for placing on record the bye-laws of respondent No.4 – Makhu Zamindara Co-operative Marketing-cum-Processing Society Limited, Makhu as Annexure P-12.

2. For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed. Annexure P-12 is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

CWP-7124 of 2024

1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the balance amount of gratuity, leave encashment, provident fund and pending salary along with interest on the delayed payment @ 18% per annum from the date of its actual accrual till realization.



2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset confines his prayer for deciding representation dated 12.11.2013 (Annexure P-9). He submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said representation is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.
6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.3 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in representation dated 12.11.2013 (Annexure P-9) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled, necessary benefits be released within a period of three weeks thereafter.
7. The petition stands disposed of.
