1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for calling the final status report on the complaint dated 06.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) from respondent No.2 and to take remedial action on the aforesaid complaint.

2. On 01.04.2024, the following order was passed :

“Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for calling the final status report on the complaint dated 06.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) from respondent No.2 and to take remedial action on the aforesaid complaint.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, inter alia, contends that petitioner No.1 and her husband-respondent No.5 resolved their matrimonial dispute and sought decree of divorce with mutual consent under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act and the learned Family Court, Chandigarh has granted the divorce by way of mutual consent on 20.10.2023. Thereafter, respondent No.5 started sending

obscene material on the email ID of petitioner No.1 from his email ID and his Whatsapp number. Even such objectionable material was also sent to the workplace, where petitioner No.1 is currently employed. The detail of the same has been provided in para No.10 of the present petition.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, PP, U.T. Chandigarh, assisted by Ms. Diksha Sharma, Advocate and Investigating Officer/Sub Inspector Hawa Singh, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents and seeks time to file the status report.

Adjourned to 23.05.2024.”

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has filed status report dated 22.05.2024 by way of an affidavit of A. Venkatesh DANIPS, DSP, Cyber Crime, UT Chandigarh on behalf of respondent No.1-UT Chandigarh, which is taken on record. A copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners. Learned Public Prosecutor submits that the jurisdictional police authority is inquiring into the veracity of the allegations leveled by the petitioner and the investigating agency has already issued notice to concerned quarters to obtain IP addresses and details of the e-mail account and the reply of the same is still awaited and the investigating agency is taking every possible step to inquire into the matter. Learned Public Prosecutor further submits that the inquiry in the present matter would be taken to the logical conclusion and it would be concluded within a period of 06 weeks.

4. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to invoke the remedies available to him in accordance with law, in case any grievance still survives.
