1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the claim of the petitioner for regularization under the Policy dated 01.10.2003 has been declined by the respondents and that too without giving any cogent reason.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents have not taken into consideration as to whether the petitioner had fulfilled all the requisite of the Policy dated 01.10.2003 and no such finding has been given. Learned counsel further submits that qua the similar question of law, this Court has already passed an order on 13.03.2024 in CWP No. 2158 of 2020 titled as ***Ashish Sharma and others Vs. State of Haryana and others*** and other connected cases, giving direction to the State to consider the claim of the employees for regularization under the Policy dated 01.10.2003 by laying down certain

parameters and the respondents should also consider the claim of the petitioner keeping in view the parameters mentioned in the said order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents concedes the factum that bunch of petitions have already been decided by this Court giving parameters as to how, the claim of the employees is to be evaluated for regularization under the Policy dated 01.10.2003.

6. Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of that in case the petitioner files a fresh representation, the said representation be decided keeping in view the parameters laid down while passing the order in CWP No. 2158 of 2020 titled as ***Ashish Sharma and others Vs. State of Haryana and others*** and other connected cases, decided on 13.03.2024, within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation.
