1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.16 dated 31.03.2023 under Sections 406 & 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Women Police Station Chandigarh, District Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 29.01.2024 (Annexure P-2).
