The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the recovery letter dated 28.08.2001 (Annexure P-4) and letter dated 26.06.2001 (Annexure P-5), refixing pay of the petitioner without any reason and order dated 20.03.2003 (Annexure P-11), whereby, the representation of the petitioner has been rejected.
