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As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.3,90,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the claimants. Counsel further submitted that the entire enhanced amount be paid to Jagsir Singh S/o Devi Dayal being legal heir of Bhagwan Kaur, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to both the Insurance Companies (Respondents 2 and 4) to each deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.1,95,000/- (Rs.3,90,000/- in total) favouring Jagsir Singh S/o Devi Dayal being legal heir of Bhagwan Kaur with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant/appellants.

Appeal stands disposed of.
