PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to respondent No.2 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner as he apprehends threat from respondent No.4, who happens to be a police official.
2. Status report has been filed which shows that there is a preliminary inquiry being conducted on the complaint made by wife of the petitioner against him. At the heart of the controversy lies a matrimonial discord. From the perusal of the status report, this Court is satisfied that the petitioner is being dealt with in accordance with law.
3. In view of above, no further order is warranted. However, Mr. Ali submits that he will be satisfied if the authorities are directed to look into the pleas raised by the petitioner during the course of preliminary inquiry. This Court is sanguine that the authorities will consider the same and there is nothing on record to suggest otherwise.

4. Consequently, the present petition is disposed off.
