1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act along with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 23.12.2021 passed by this Court in CWP-5119-2021.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that pursuant to order dated 23.12.2021 passed in CWP-5119-2021, the petitioners have been offered appointment. They have already joined the duties and necessary benefits qua pay fixation and fixation of seniority have been granted to the petitioners after fixing their salary notionally at par with their juniors. Therefore, there is no violation of the order of the Court.
3. In view of the above, this Court does not find any reason to continue with the present petition any more. Hence, the same is dismissed.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
