1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order of transfer dated 11/14.03.2024 (Annexure P-8) is contrary to the transfer policy issued by the respondents hence, the petitioner is entitled to continue at the present place of posting at Ambala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will file appropriate representation for the consideration of the respondents and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is received from the petitioner raising any grievance qua the transfer order dated 11/14.03.2024 (Annexure P-8), the same will be

decided within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of the same and in case, after the decision of the representation, any benefit accrues to the petitioner, the same will also be released to him otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate representation before the respondents.
