Present bunch of three writ petitions involve common question of law in the background of common set of facts and thus they are being decided by a common order.

In the present petition, the challenge is to the selection to the Post of Ayurvedic Medical Officers, which selection was also challenged by the other candidates in CWP No.5636 of 2000 titled “***Dr. Amritpal Singh and ors. Vs. State of Punjab and ors.***” as well as in CWP No.4065 of 2009 titled as “***Dr. Renuka Vs. State of Punjab and Ors.***”, which petitions have already been dismissed by the Co-ordinate Bench by order dated 24.01.2023.

Keeping in view of the fact that the selection has already been upheld, the present set of petitions are also dismissed in the terms of the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench in ***Dr. Amritpal Singh’s case (supra)***.
