1. Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 03.07.2002, (Annexure -18), whereby, the petitioner has been reverted from the post of Superintendent to that of Accountant w.e.f. 24.12.2001.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the writ petition was admitted vide order dated 19.08.2003 and further proceedings were stayed. He further submits that reversion of the petitioner has been annulled by the Market Committee Abohar, vide resolution No.3 dated 27.12.2021 and the said resolution has been approved by the Punjab Mandi Board vide order dated 30.10.2024 and the Secretary Market Committee, Abohar was directed to take necessary action in accordance with rules as per resolution No.3 dated 27.12.2021. and thereafter, vide resolution dated 19.11.2024, the Market



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Committee, Abohar has resolved to give benefits to the petitioner on annulment of his reversion.

3. The said fact has been affirmed by counsel for respondents No.1 and 2. In this view of the matter, directions are issued to respondent No.1 and 2 to release all the consequential benefits to the petitioner on account of revocation of his reversion from the post of Superintendent to Accountant within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is also entitled for interest on the said benefits and he may be given liberty to make a detailed representation to the respondents to that effect.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file representation before the respondents. In case, if any such representation is submitted by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and disposed of by the respondents within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of representation.
