The five petitioners namely Parveen, Jaibir, Dinesh, Sunder @ Bholu and Rajender prays for their release on regular bail by way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.26 dated 06.02.2024 registered under Sections 147, 149, 308, 323, 427, 452, 506 of the IPC registered at Police Station Lakhna Majra, Rohtak.

2. Allegations are that on 05.02.2024, all of them along with co-accused caused injuries to Shivam, Vikas and Ravinder, attracting Sections 308 & 323 of the IPC.

3. Learned counsel contends that total five injuries were found to have been caused to the three injured namely Shivam, Vikas and Ravinder

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and that all of them have been found to be simple in nature. Learned counsel also contends that petitioners are in custody for the last more than 03 months with no other criminal case pending against them and so, they be allowed bail.

4. Status report by way of an affidavit of Shri Sandeep Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Meham, District Rohtak has been filed on behalf of respondent- State, in which it is conceded that total five injuries are caused to three injured Shivam, Ravinder and Vikas and all five of them have been opined by the Medical Officer to be simple in nature. Petitioners are in custody since 20.02.2024. Trial may take time to conclude.

5. Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioners are admitted to bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
