1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, claiming the following reliefs:-

"i) Issue a writ in the nature of certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order or direction quashing the impugned show cause notices dated 10.03.2004 (received by the petitioner on 15.03.2004) Annexure P-7, vide which the petitioner has been asked to show cause as to why they be not reverted from the post of Junior Engineer.

It is further prayed that during the pendency of the writ petition, the reversion of the petitioner may kindly be stayed."

2. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 23.05.2024 and notice was ordered to be issued to the petitioner for 08.08.2024.

3. As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved with the report that the petitioner has retired from service.



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4. Learned State counsel on instructions from Sh. Jaswinder Singh, Senior Assistant, Deptt. of Local Government, Punjab, submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has further been promoted to the post of Assistant Corporation Engineer and has retired from service.
5. In this view of the matter, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
