Main case

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the dismissal of the
petitioner from service on 31.05.2021, was primarily on account of his
conviction under Sections 420 and 506 IPC. However, appeal against which
was pending wherein he has stands acquitted vide judgment dated 06.07.2022
passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar.

Learned counsel in instructions submits that the petitioner shall

file a representation alongwith the judgment for reconsideration of the matter.

To this limited prayer, learned State counsel has no objection.

In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case the petitioner submit a representation within 4 weeks, the same shall be decided expeditiously.
