The petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking appropriate directions to the respondents No.3 to 5 not to harass the petitioners and their family members on the behest of private respondent No.6 by summoning the petitioners in police Station repeatedly, time and again on the basis of same complaint as the given complaints have already been dealt with after registering DDR, recording the statement of both the parties, and now again calling the petitioner to police station with regard to same complaint by the same complainant is an abuse of process of law.

Status report by way of an affidavit of Karan Singh Sandhu, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kharar –1, District S.A.S. Nagar, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5, in compliance of order dated 24.01.2024 passed by this Hon’ble Court is taken on record.

From perusal of para No.5 of the report, it is crystal clear that all the complaints given by respondent No.6 against the petitioners stand closed/filed and the petitioners are not required by the police with regard to any complaint or FIR pending against them.

In the light of above, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
