1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari for quashing the order dated 06.10.2022 (Annexure P-5) passed by the respondent-Corporation, whereby 100% provisional pension of the petitioner, sanctioned from the date of his retirement, has been ordered to be stopped on the basis of conviction order dated 02.09.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Special Court, Gurdaspur, against the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that during the pendency of the present petition, order dated 18.07.2023 has been passed by the respondent-Corporation, whereby the leave encashment and gratuity of the petitioner has been released and with regard to the pension, it has been stated that provisional pension of the petitioner has already been ordered to be released from the date of retirement w.e.f.

01.05.2022 till the date of his conviction and since he has been held guilty of serious crime, which amounts serious misconduct which led to his conviction, therefore, his provisional pension has been ordered to be withdrawn.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
