JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to re-issue passport to her son.

2. The son of the petitioner is residing in New Zealand. An FIR came to be registered against him. The said FIR has been lodged by his estranged wife. As per the petitioner, vide order dated 13.02.2024 passed by Family Court at New Zealand, the marriage between son of the petitioner and his wife has been dissolved. He now wants to come to India to settle criminal case pending against him.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Karan Kumar Jund, Senior Panel Counsel, who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-Union of India and waives service. He submits that if petitioner applies for emergency certificate it would be expeditiously issued. He further submits that application seeking passport shall be kept pending.

5. In the wake of statement of counsel for Union of India, the present petition stands disposed of.
