Main case

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners got married on 9.12.2022 and it was arranged marriage but thereafter, difference arose between the families of both the parties who made efforts to break the marriage of the parties. Subsequently, both the petitioners agreed for co-habitation and again started living together with effect from 17.3.2024 but respondents No.4 to 7 are against the petitioners and are extending threats to cause harm to them and in this regard, representation (Annexure P-5) dated 20.3.2024 is given to respondent No.2 but the police authorities are unable to take any action in this regard.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf

of State of Haryana. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Superintendent of Police, Ambala to consider representation dated 20.3.2024 (Annexure P-5) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
