The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 29.01.2003 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2, with a direction to the respondents to pay the interest @ 24% per annum on delayed payment of retiral and other benefits of the petitioner from the date of retirement till its actual payment.
2. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and the respondents on the last date of hearing i.e. 07.05.2024 and notices were ordered to be issued to the petitioner and the respondents for 09.07.2024.
3. As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved with the report "not found at the given address" and notices issued to the respondents have been received back duly served. However, there is no representation on behalf of the respondents.
4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same in case, any cause still survives.
