1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 06.11.2023 passed in CWP-8741-2019.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
4. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 06.11.2023 passed in CWP-8741-2019 has been complied with and necessary speaking order dated 23.02.2024 has been passed. Copy of the order dated 23.02.2024 (in vernacular) produced by the counsel for the respondents in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
5. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
6. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
7. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
