1. The respondents/contemnors along with their counsel Mr. R.S. Panghal, are present in Court today and have submitted their separate affidavit(s) in Court today, wherein, they have tendered an unconditional apology for certain contemptuous remarks being made against the Judicial Officers concerned. The said affidavits are taken on record.

2. This Court has assessed the demeanor of the respondents/contemnors. Consequently, it has come to the conclusion that the respondents/contemnors are sufficiently humbled, besides are making a soulful atonement in respect of the purported contempt committed by them. Thus, the proceedings against the respondents/contemnors are dropped, however, as stated in the affidavit, the contemptuous pleadings as raised in *CRM-M-2603-2024*, are permitted to be deleted.

3. In consequence, since the respondents/contemnors have purged themselves of contempt, as such, the contempt petition is closed and the Rule is discharged.
