NAMIT KUMAR, J.(ORAL)

1. On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the respondent-PSEB/PSPCL submits that the appellant was initially appointed as Assistant Lineman on 20.02.1980 on Ad hoc basis and thereafter on 21.02.1981, he was appointed as Assistant Lineman on regular basis and was further promoted as Lineman on 17.07.1995 and retired as such on 31.08.2014 and thereafter, unfortunately died on 13.04.2017. The claim of the appellant in the suit was for promotion to the post of Lineman from the year 1986.

The present appeal was filed through Mr.Ravinder Chopra, Advocate, who is no more in this world. Although Ms.Gauri C. Kaushal, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of appellant and she submits that she is not in contact with the family members of the appellant.

The present appeal pertains to the year 1996 and the same is pending before this Court for more than 27 years and is taken up after considerable time.

Learned counsel for the appellants seeks some time to do all possible efforts to get in touch with the legal representatives of the appellant and to seek instructions in the matter.

Adjourned to 14.02.2024.”

2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that he has not received any instructions from the family members of the appellant to pursue the present appeal.
3. In view of the above, the present appeal is dismissed for want of prosecution, with liberty to the appellant for revival of the present appeal, in case the legal representative(s) of the appellant wishes to pursue the present matter.
