NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The appellants have filed the instant appeal against judgment and decree dated 10.02.1996, passed by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Faridkot, whereby suit for declaration filed by the respondent/plaintiff has been decreed and judgment and decree dated 19.02.1997 passed by learned Additional District Judge, Faridkot, whereby an appeal filed by the appellants/defendants against judgment and decree dated 10.02.1996, has been dismissed.
2. During the pendency of the present appeal, on an appeal filed by the plaintiff/respondent, he has been ordered to be reinstated in service with the rider that he would not be entitled for any salary and allowances and any other benefit for the period of absence and the time spent out of duty, vide order dated 22.07.2004, passed by the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Faridkot Range, Faridkot. It is also the case of the plaintiff/respondent himself that after his reinstatement, he was



posted as Head Constable and was promoted as Assistant Sub Inspector vide order dated 04.12.2009 and further to the post of Sub Inspector w.e.f. 22.09.2016, vide order dated 03.01.2017. Thereafter, he was further promoted as Inspector vide order dated 16.03.2017 and he has retired as such on 31.03.2017 and he was sanctioned and disbursed pension and G.P.F., however, the other pensionary benefits are still due.

3. In this view of the matter, the claim raised by the plaintiff/respondent in the suit has been rendered infructuous in view of the subsequent order dated 22.07.2004, passed by the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Faridkot Range, Faridkot and therefore, the instant appeal has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
