The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking quashing of orders dated 11.12.2023(Annexure P-4) and 19.02.2024(Annexure P-5) passed by the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar in a criminal case having FIR No.19 dated 18.02.2019 registered under Sections 420 of IPC at Police Station Airport, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted regular bail vide order dated 28.02.2019(Annexure P-2) by the learned trial Court and thereafter petitioner was regularly appearing but got absented on 11.12.2023 due to noting down of wrong date. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that this was first default on part of the petitioner but despite this learned trial Court issued proclamation vide order dated 19.02.2024(Annexure P-5). He further submits that the absence of the petitioner before the trial Court was not intentional at all and that the petitioner is ready to join the proceedings before the trial Court.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that petitioner jumped bail on 11.12.2023 and consequently trial Court passed order (Annexure P-4) and thereafter trial Court also issued proclamation of the petitioner vide order dated 19.02.2024 (Annexure P-5) by following due course of law.
5. In view of the fact that the petitioner was granted regular bail by the trial Court vide order dated 28.02.2019 (Annexure P-2) and thereafter the petitioner was regularly appearing before the trial Court and jumped bail on 11.12.2023, the present petition is disposed of in the interest of law and in order to avoid further delay in trial with direction to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on or before the next date fixed and on his doing so, the petitioner is to be released on regular bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction subject to cost of Rs.7,000/- to be deposited by the petitioner with the District Legal Services Authority concerned.
