1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner was entitled for two marks on account of experience which have not been extended to him due to which, the petitioner was not selected for the post of Junior Engineer as advertised vide Advertisement No.10 of 2019 dated 15.06.2019 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 19.04.2023 (Annexure P-6) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the representation dated 19.04.2023 (Annexure P-6) will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the decision of the representation, any benefit accrues to the petitioner, the same will also be released to him otherwise, due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
