1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 ad 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 03.08.2023 passed in CWP-16727-2023.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of Ashok Kumar Meena, Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Haryana, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 03.08.2023 passed in CWP-16727-2023 has since been complied with. The claim of the petitioner has been considered and decided and the petitioner has been offered appointment to the post of Taxation Inspector in Excise and Taxation Department, Haryana.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
