It is not disputed by the learned counsel that the petitioner earlier approached this Court with the similar prayer, and the petition was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 02.02.2024. It is, however, contended that the petitioner again moved representation dated 05.02.2024, Annexure P-10 with the respondents for conducting enquiry which has not been decided as yet. Therefore, he has a right to file the instant petition.

2.                Once the earlier petition with similar relief has been dismissed as withdrawn, mere filing of a representation with the respondents will not give any fresh cause to the petitioner to approach this Court. The instant petition, in these circumstances, is an abuse of the process of law.

3.                Accordingly, the petition hereby stands dismissed with costs of Rs.5000/- to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar

Association, Lawyers’ Family Welfare Fund, Chandigarh, within two weeks.
