Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.109 dated 12.09.2022 under Section18(C), 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

2. At the outset, learned counsel contends that similarly placed co-accused Sandeep Kumar @ Seepa has been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 20.03.2024 in CRM-M-5891-2024 (Annexure P-2).

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. G.P.S. Bhullar, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

5. Learned State counsel could not refute the aforesaid contention to the effect that case of the petitioner on parity.

6. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, particularly on the basis of parity and for all the reasons as have been mentioned in order dated 20.03.2024, Annexure P-2 and also taken into account the custody period of the petitioner which is 01 year 06 months and 24 days but without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to

regular bail and is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
