1. Keeping in view the averments made in the application, exemption from filing the certified copies of documents (Annexures P-1 to P-7), is allowed.
2. Disposed of.

Main case

1. Instant petition under Section 482 Cr.PC has been preferred seeking directions to the official respondents to take action against the accused in case FIR as mentioned below: -

2. Heard.

3. It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner being aggrieved by the acts and conduct of the accused had moved a complaint to the police and had also supplied the copies of the photographs of the incident (Annexures P-3 to P-7) along with a pen drive (Annexure P-8) but the police had simply registered the aforesaid FIR No. 15 dated 06.02.2024, under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 34 and 294 IPC.

4. She further submits that the petitioner has even moved a representation dated 19.02.2024 (Annexure P-2) before the Police Commissioner, Ludhiana, but no action has been taken thereon.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-2) in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner by giving the petitioner an opportunity of being heard.

6. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

7. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents and submits that the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-2) will be decided in an expeditious manner.

8. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction

to respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Mini Secretariat, Ludhiana to consider the averments made in the representation dated 19.02.2024 (Annexure P-2), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

9. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
10. Disposed of.
