By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.6 dated 25.01.2024 registered under Sections 308, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Qila Lal Singh, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Khushbir Kaur, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala has been filed on behalf of the respondent- State.

In an occurrence took place on 24.01.2024, petitioner along with others, is alleged to have caused injuries to Jagpreet Singh. In the supplementary statement made by complainant- Ramandeep Kaur, the wife of injured Jagpreet Singh, injury No.1 on the head of Jagpreet has been attributed to the petitioner. The said injury has been opined to be dangerous to life.

Learned State Counsel also informs that injured – Jagpreet Singh is still in comatose position.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that supplementary statement has been made by complainant after two months of the occurrence.

At this stage, there is no reason to disbelieve the statement made by the complainant even if made after two months of the occurrence, particularly when the police has not been not able to record the statement of injured- Jagpreet Singh, who is still lying in the comatose position.

No ground is made out to grant the anticiaptory bail to the petitioner.
