1. The prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 15 dated 07.01.2021 under Sections 379-B(2), 341, 201, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Islamabad, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

2. Vide order dated 22.03.2024, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation. The same is reproduced as under:-

*“ Apprehending his arrest in FIR No.15 dated 07.01.2021. registered under Sections 379-B(2)/341/201/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act at Police Station Islamabad, Amritsar, District Amritsar, petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail.*



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*Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the trial has already resulted in acquittal of the co-accused.*

*Notice of motion for 27.05.2024.*

*On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.*

*In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer. As and when called, the petitioner shall join the investigation. He shall abide by the conditions enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.”*

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jasbir Singh (Belt No.2212) Amritsar, submits that in compliance of order dated 22.03.2024, petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the order dated 22.03.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

6. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
