1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 24.02.2020 (Annexure P-28) vide which the petitioner has been awarded the punishment of compulsorily retirement w.e.f. 11.02.2020 and also order dated 25.02.2020 (Annexure P-29) for relieving the petitioner.

2. On 09.06.2020, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had stayed the operation of the impugned order till the next date of hearing.

3. Learned State Counsel has submitted that at any rate, by now, the petitioner would have retired and thus, in all probability, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

4. Today, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner in order to rebut the abovesaid aspect.
5. Accordingly, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
6. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to her.
