By way of present petition, the petitioner is seeking a direction to respondents Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 6 and not to allow anybody else to interfere with the liberty and life of the petitioner or not to intrude into the privacy of the petitioner in any manner.

It is stated that petitioner has filed divorce petition against respondent No.4-husband which is pending adjudication (Annexure P-2). Respondent Nos.4 to 6 are threatening the petitioner to face dire consequences, as a result thereof, the petitioner is living under constant threat.

The petitioner has approached the respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot by way of representation dated 20.03.2024 (Annexure P-3), but no action has been taken thereon. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would be satisfied if her

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representation dated 20.03.2024 is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amandeep Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and on a perusal of the paper book, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot to look into the representation dated 20.03.2024 (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioner and if necessary to take appropriate action on the same, as per law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one month.

Disposed of.
