Since Criminal Revision No.765 of 2019, is directed against the affirmative order passed on the application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C. by the public prosecutor concerned, wherethroughs, the arraignment of the said respondent in the said petition, as accused, was asked for, but when it is stated, at the bar, that the said respondent, who joined trial with the other co-accused, rather has been acquitted of the charges framed against her, as such, Criminal Revision bearing CRR No.765 of 2019, is rendered infructuous, inasmuch as, the order passed thereons has merged in the final verdict passed by the learned trial Court concerned.
