- 1. The learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him, by the officer concerned, submits that Annexure P-7 is appealed by the aggrieved before the competent Appellate Authority.
- 2. In the light of the above, the mandamus as asked for in the instant writ petition for enforcing Annexure P-7 is not maintainable.
