The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to take action on the representation dated 30.12.2019 as respondents No.5 and 6 are threatening the petitioner to withdraw the complaint dated 03.12.2019 (Annexure P-2).

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

The learned State counsel, while referring to the reply dated 16.07.2022 states that the petitioner is a chronic litigant and as many as 19 petitions have been filed by him before this Court, which have either been dismissed or disposed of. In FIR No.149 of 2013, PS Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana registered by the petitioner, a cancellation report was prepared and

submitted in the year 2014. Thereafter, the petitioner filed multiple representations for re-investigation, which took place and culminated in second cancellation report dated 04.04.2023.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.
