1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 11 read with Section 2(b) and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 31.10.2023 passed in CRM-M-23984-2023.
2. Compliance affidavit of Varun Sharma, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 31.10.2023 passed in CRM-M-23984-2023 has since been complied with and the investigating agency has filed the cancellation report in FIR No.14 dated 25.01.2023, Police Station Banur.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
